COPACC SPACES

The Auditorium is a 300 plus seat theatre with cinema projection facilities and comfortable cinema style seating. It is ideal for performances and large audio visual presentations.

The Gallery Space within the main foyer, has natural light. The main wall is fitted with a gallery tracking system and track lighting.

The Civic Hall is an ideal function venue with a variety of configurations: a 180 seat dining/cabaret venue; or a stage with tiered seating for 140; or an intimate performance/conference space with flat floor seating for up to 250 people.

The modular design of the Civic Hall and adjoining rooms accommodates functions for 300+ people in cabaret style, including a band stage and dance floor.



Meeting Room 1 features include an audio system, data projection and a small kitchenette.

Meeting Room 2 is equipped with an audio system and data projection.

Meeting Rooms 1 & 2 combine into a single space perfect for corporate meetings and dinners.

The Rehearsal Room is equipped with an audio system, data projection and kitchenette.

The Green Room is an intimate space equipped with a small kitchenette. This room is frequently used for interviews, business coaching and small-group meetings.
